Notification pursuant to Article 3 of the Convention on Environmental Impact Assessment in a Transboundary Context (Espoo Convention) regarding a planned offshore wind farm in the Sea of Bothnia in Sweden's economic zone, called "Sylen"

According to article 3 point 1 of the Espoo Convention, affected countries shall be notified and consulted on projects that are likely to cause transboundary environmental impacts. As a party of origin, Sweden hereby notifies Finland regarding the plans for the offshore windfarm "Sylen", in the Sea of Bothnia.

Information on the project

The developer, Svea Vind Offshore AB intends to apply for a permit under the Swedish Economic Zone Act (1992:1140) and the Continental Shelf Act (1966:314) to construct and operate the wind farm Sylen within Sweden's economic zone. A maximum of 347 wind turbines are planned with a maximum total height of 350 meters covering an area of approximately 524 km². The facility will consist of offshore wind turbines on fixed foundations, offshore transformer stations on fixed foundations, measurement masts and cables laid in water within the group station and transmission cables to land.

The project area is located within Sweden's economic zone, in the Gulf of Bothnia outside of Hudiksvall and Söderhamn municipalities.

Attached to this notification letter is information about the planned wind farm's location, scope and design, and the preliminary content and design of the EIA.

Future permit applications with associated EIA will be designed based on what emerges during the consultations and will be supplemented with investigations. The investigations, together with opinions from consultations, will form the basis for the final design of the wind farm and form the basis for the

- 4. submit any comments you might receive from the public in Finland.
